A group of 5 workmen were deployed in chipping and housekeeping work at OTS area b/w flat no 02 and 04 of Tower 4 . The injured pers on while loading the debris in to a basin, a 1m length steel rod of 12mm thickness fell from height and pierced in to his helmet, injuring his skull bone. Due to high impact force, the rod penetrated 1.5 inch in to his right occipital region of his head
